



Revision Tracking and Comparison Pages in MediaWiki – Each Article



The details of <u>all edits</u> are kept (1) who changed it, (2) what was changed, (3) when it was done

Revert to Previous Version of an Article (Undo Edits)

1. Click 'View history'



- 1. Click 'View history'
- 2. Select (click on the date/time) of the (previous) version
- 3. Once the previous version is displayed click 'edit' (ignore the warning that one is editing an old version)
- 4. Save changes... like you would save any page edits!
